### What I've Been Working On

Since January, I've served on several ACBL committees: Audit, Governance/Communications, Bridge/Executive Initiatives, and the International Stakeholders Task Force.

As a member of the ACBL Board's Audit Committee, I participated in this year's review of the annual independent audit of ACBL's financials. In 2025, we worked for the first time with CBIZ, the firm selected through a 2024 sourcing process. After thorough Committee review and discussions with both CBIZ and ACBL Management, we were pleased to receive an unqualified (i.e., "clean") audit opinion.

On the Bridge/Executive Director initiatives, we are actively reviewing and updating policies and procedures for Local Sectionals. This work includes evaluating best practices, assessing whether Local Sectionals should continue, and clarifying the parameters for how they may be hosted and managed going forward.

I've also addressed one of my longstanding concerns: tackling ACBL's unfair foreign exchange rates applied to clubs and tournaments. From January 1, 2025, when I assumed my position on the Board of Directors, through July 31, the USD exchange rate charged by the ACBL was 44%—about 7% higher than standard banking rates—effectively generating a profit on the exchange. While the ACBL earns revenue from table fees and sanction fees, it should not be profiting on foreign exchange rates at the expense of Canadian clubs and tournaments.

I'm pleased to share that, effective August 1, the ACBL will adjust the foreign exchange rates monthly – fairer and more transparent. A big win for our clubs and particularly our tournaments! 🎉

### Board of Directors Meeting – Summer 2025 Highlights

The Board met in Philadelphia July 21-24. The Board and Committees continue to meet regularly through Microsoft Teams and Zoom.

#### Financial Performance

- June Gain from operations: \$153k (+\$77k above budget).

- YTD net assets up \$687k; \$13.7M in cash/investments.

- Foreign exchange policy revised to allow greater operational flexibility.

#### Membership

- Total membership: 121,499 (-6% vs. 2024).

- 4,145 new members YTD (+2.4% vs. prior year).

#### Growing the Game

- New Sapphire Access Program to exclusive merchandise, participation and learning with badge and access to exclusive merchandise.

- Guest Memberships are now free and permanent with access to MyACBL portal, strategy tips, and up to 20 masterpoints before converting to full membership.

#### Support for Units & Districts

- Online events will no longer be approved at F2F regional tournaments.

- Regional tournament planning guide being updated with best practices.

- Strong push toward pre-registration for better staffing and planning.

- Review underway for Local Sectionals to better plan post-pandemic needs.

#### Fair Play & Discipline

- EDGAR cheating detection continues; ~900 players sanctioned to date.

- New policies allow limited club play for flagged players (under strict conditions).

- Other (pre-2022) cases will be reviewed.

#### Ethics

- Ethics certification revised to allow "No Contest" pleas.

#### Governance

- Ongoing simplification of the ACBL Codification.

- Management adopted to improve transparency, structure, reporting, agenda.

- New Board Resource Manual nearing completion.

#### Other Initiatives

- Hall of Fame election procedures simplified and updated.

- International Stakeholders Task Force formed to clarify ACBL's international relationships.

- Experimental model for Fall 2028 NABC being explored (focused on national).

- New Titanium Point masterpoint class under consideration for high-performing players under 10,000 points.

- Toronto is a top candidate for hosting the Summer 2031 NABC.

- Darren Wolpert; NPC: Marc-André Fourcaudot.

- Mark Aquino appointed ABA Liaison for 2025-26.
